THE DON ZIMMERMAN GOLDEN APPLE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Don Zimmerman Golden Apple Scholarship awards a full scholarship for the Rockford University master's program to a teacher who has shown dedication to the craft of teaching and a passion for the profession. This scholarship will be awarded every other year. The scholarship must be completed in two years.

ELIGIBILITY-(Must Meet All):

- Certified Pre-K-12th grade teacher who has completed a minimum of two years as a full-time teacher
- Currently teaching full-time in a public school or ISBE recognized non-public school in Winnebago or Boone County
- Employed in **good standing** within current school district
- Maintain a minimum 2.5 GPA
- Must have applied for admittance to Rockford University's master's program **prior** to application submission.

PROCESS:

- Complete application packet and submit to the Golden Apple Foundation office by **5 p.m. Wednesday**, **June 5, 2024.**
- Type or print clearly. If using a computer or word processor, you may use your own paper, but only use the amount of space and size of paper indicated on the application.
- Complete all four required components of the Application Packet:
- A. <u>Background Information</u>- Include most relevant information for this process.
- B. <u>Self-Reflective Essay-</u> Submit no more than three double-spaced, typed pages with no smaller than font size 10. *Do not* staple your application materials. *Provide an in-depth answer, including specific illustrative examples to this question: Tell us about your commitment to teaching. How would a scholarship affect you, your students and your school?*
 - Your essay allows our selection committee to understand the importance of the work you do as a teacher and how the scholarship could make a difference.
- **C.** <u>Letters of Recommendation-</u>Provide two and <u>only</u> two letters of recommendation. Be sure at least one is from your principal, who is familiar with your classroom teaching and can verify that you are a teacher in good standing. Each person sending a recommendation letter must include his/her name, address and relationship to the applicant.
- **D.** Authorization-Attest to authorization and eligibility criteria with signature.
